To qualify as a merit badge counselor for Citizenship in Society, you must:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Be proficient in the merit badge subject by vocation, avocation, or special training.
- Be able to work with scout aged youth
- Attach your current Youth Protection Certificate.
- Complete Merit Badge Counselor training and attach certificate. [Merit Badge Counselor Training - Boy Scouts of America, Northern New Jersey Council \(nnjbsa.org\)](https://www.nnjbsa.org/merit-badge-counselor-training)
- Complete BSA Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion training (SCO-1800) and attach your certificate.

This course can be located within your my.scouting Account.

- First time applicants must attach a completed Boy Scouts of America Adult Application. Per BSA National Policy: Include a completed Adult Leader Application if you are not currently approved as a Merit Badge Counselor. (Keep a copy of this application for your records.)
